

Effective March 14, 2019, changes have been made to remove the previously-displayed jail total from the Sentencing screen in Docket, the Journal Entry and Order, the Order of Probation screen in DOCKET, and the automated probation order that is generated through Docket. These changes have been made due to the fact that the jail total was not being calculated correctly when there were multiple counts with jail sentences on a case.

1. When jail sentences are entered in the Pleas/Dispo screen, the calculated jail total will no longer display in the Sentencing screen as shown below. The amount of jail entered for each count can still be reviewed by clicking the What button prior to signing.



2. When the Docket entry is signed and completed, the calculated jail total will no longer appear on the Journal Entry and Order. Instead, the JE&O will read, "Defendant is sentenced to the (Correctional Facility), for terms as shown above, and is to pay costs of this prosecution", as shown below.

3. When Automated Probation is selected in the Sentencing screen and probation terms are being entered in the Order of Probation screens, the calculated jail total will no longer display. Instead, the jail suspension date will display as shown below.

4. When the Docket entry is signed and completed, the calculated jail total will no longer appear on the probation order under the "JAIL" probation term. Instead, as shown in the image below, the jail sentence for each count will be listed at the top of the probation order and the "JAIL" probation term will read "Serve jail term(s) beginning (date) as shown above."

- 1. Refrain from unlawful conduct.
- 2. Avoid places or persons of disreputable or harmful character.
- Report to the Probation Office as directed by the Court or Probation Office and permit the Probation Officer to visit his/her home.
- Answer any reasonable inquiries on the part of the Court or Probation Officer concerning his/her conduct or condition.
- 5. Report any changes of address immediately to the Probation Officer.
- 6. Show proof of compliance with any of the special conditions specified below.

The following special conditions have been added by the Court to further the rehabilitation of the Defendant:

- 8. JAIL Serve jail term(s) beginning 3/18/2019 as shown above.
- 9. NODRIVE The defendant shall not drive a motor vehicle for 45 days.
- 10. INTERLOCK After any required period of no driving, the defendant is ordered to apply for an ignition interlock permit, shall install an approved ignition interlock device on any motor vehicle that he or she operates, and shall not operate a motor vehicle until equipped with such device, and having obtained an Ignition Interlock Permit. The defendant shall maintain an Ignition Interlock Permit concurrent with the revocation period of
